Annual Assessment Dues

Deadline Extended

As stated in the **Declarations of Restrictions #2** "The annual assessment shall be due and payable by February 1st of each year. This year they are to be paid by February 15th. A late charge of \$25 will be added to any late payment and an additional \$25 for each thirty (30) days past due (calculated from February 15th)... The foregoing annual assessment charge shall constitute a lien upon each lot until paid." Article XI of the By-Laws states: "All assessments, which are not paid by the due date, shall be deemed delinquent and may be secured by a lien upon the property against which the assessment is made. The Association may bring action at law against the Owner personally obligated to pay the same or foreclose the lien against the property. Interest, costs, and reasonable attorney's fees of any such action shall be added to the amount of such assessment." The homeowner association board will be actively enforcing the above restriction and by-laws so please have your annual assessment of \$275 postmarked no later than February 15, 2008.

Who Let the Dogs Out??

A little reminder to pet owners - restriction #45 states "Pets shall not be permitted to run "free" but shall be kept within the dwelling, or in an approved fenced area, to include invisible electrical fences, located on the lot." If your dog leaves something behind on your walk please respect your neighbor's property by carrying a plastic bag with you and cleaning up their waste. It is a common courtesy not to mention the right thing to do!

Recipe of the Month

Chicken Cacciatore

Skin chicken and sprinkle with Italian herbs (oregano, thyme, and basil). Bake at 375 degrees for 45 minutes covered in foil.

Stir fry cut up peppers (red, green, yellow, etc.), onion and mushrooms. Pour in a can of spaghetti sauce after they are cooked.

Pour sauce over chicken and put back in the oven for 45 minutes.

Serve with garlic noodles. Smash some garlic and let it soak in some olive oil while the pasta is cooking. Stir this garlic oil into the pasta and then stir in parmesan cheese.
