### Fruit Pizza

1 tub or 2 packages of Pillsbury Break & Bake sugar cookies

- Arrange cookies or spread dough so that it will cover whatever size/type pizza pan or cookie sheet you may be using. Dough will spread as it bakes--but not very much--maybe 1/2 an inch. Bake according to package directions and allow to cool.



Pizza "sauce": 8 oz. softened cream cheese  
1/2 cup sugar  
2 teaspoons vanilla

Beat until smooth and spread on baked cookie dough.

Arrange fruit on pizza. I used fresh pineapple, strawberries and bananas, but any kind of fruit will work--be creative!

Glaze: 1/2 cup sugar  
1/2 cup water  
1/2 cup orange juice  
1/8 cup lemon juice  
1 Tablespoon corn starch

Boil until thick. Pour over fruit and chill.

The mailboxes should be painted with high-gloss black paint; they should have no visible rust and the inevitable bird remnants should be removed periodically. To ensure compliance, it is recommended that if you need a new mailbox to purchase at Lowes item #C1600B00. Mailbox **address plates also must be uniform.** If lost or in need of replacement, they can be purchased from Cornerstone Sign & Decal. Contact them at (502) 968-8759 or get in touch with any board member to order a new aluminum address plate with reflective numbers; the cost is \$20. The flag should be red.
